they could behold in its pages the unity, the omnipotence and goodness of God the Creator—although the heavens proclaimed the glory of God and the firmament announced the works of his hand—although all creation, with its infinite beauties and evidences of an omnipotent Creator—the verdure of the field, the perfume of the opening flower, the fragrance of Summer fields, the singing of joyous birds, the rustling of the forest, the parting of the stream, the roar of the cataract, the immensity of the ocean, the height and grandeur and majesty of the mountain—all creation, I say, spoke with a million voices of the power and majesty and goodness of God the Creator, men would neither see nor hear the evidences and the voices of Nature; "but they changed," as St. Paul says (first chapter Ep. to the Romans), "the glory of the incorruptible God into the likeness of the image of corruptible man, and of birds and quadrupeds and reptiles; they changed God's truth into falsehood, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator.

Such, in a word, was the religious condition of the people. The masses were the slaves of the most degrading superstitions; vices were deified and worshipped; the learned few were skeptics or atheists; the world was one vast temple of idol, whilst the great and eternal God—the author of the universe—was not acknowledged by the works of His hands. He was an outlaw of his own creation. But I must hurry to a close. I have endeavored to give a glimpse of the greatness, the power, the splendour of imperial Rome; its grand political unity, and the majesty of its peace, in the days of Augustus Caesar. I have sketched the causes of its unparalleled greatness and civilization; and I have then called attention to some of the causes that led to the decline and fall of the grandest political structure, that ever raised on earth by the sagacity, the genius and the bravery of mankind. The picture has its lights and shadows—the lights of the most brilliant civilization, and the shadows of an intense moral corruption. Imperial Rome was the most striking demonstration of all that man can do in the natural order, and of the little, or the nothing, that he can effect in the supernatural order. He can build cities, organize armies and construct empires; but he cannot make a religion that will save or sanctify one human soul, nor erect a tower by which he can go up into Heaven. Man is great in his own sphere; but his moral condition in the days of Augustus Caesar proves that he can do nothing without God in the work of his moral regeneration, and that God, in His infinite love, must come down from Heaven to lift up fallen man, to enlighten him by His eternal verities, and to purify and sanctify him by His heavenly graces. And, at this time, when man was greatest and happiest; when he was at once most powerful and most powerless, when he was at the same time on the highest pinnacles of material civilization and at the very bottom of the abyss of moral corruption, an event occurred that has made and always will make the reign of Augustus Caesar forever memorable in the annals of mankind, and crowned it with a glory that shines solitary and alone in the history of the world.

In the closing years of the reign of the great Emperor a child is born of poor parents in a stable in an obscure town in Judea. This child, grown up into man's estate, will speak as no man had ever spoken before; the infinite wisdom that dwells corporally in Him will shine out on a sun-darkened world, with the light and the power of a transfiguration. He will change the whole current of human history and reverse the whole order of ideas which men held most dear. He will enlighten the dark problems of human life and solve all its perplexing mysteries. He will enlighten man's mind and purify and sanctify his heart. He will create a new civilization and introduce a new government. He will raise up the family and its sacred ties from the degradation and disruption inflicted on it by paganism, and restore it to its legitimate position in the social order. The cruel wrongs of mankind He will rectify and the principles of eternal justice He will firmly establish; for with a divine authority He will teach the brotherhood and equality of man,
