Directions for Various Patterns in Decorative Work.

Towelling embroidery is the name given to all work carried out upon Java canvas, honeycomb, or white or stone-colored linens such as are used for towels.

Select a rather strong and coarse linen material; cut it to the size required, including a space of two inches for the fringe.

Take a piece of fine crocheted cotton, and work with it the pattern formed of the threads left in the material when the rest have been drawn away.

Velvet work upon an embossed fabric is easy and effective. It consists in outlining with gold thread the embossed flowers and arabesques and filling in the centre of such parts with satin stitch.
