## Distinguished Medical Men on its Prescrip tion in Cases of Disease.

The total abstinence section of the British Medical Association never fail to testify at the annual meeting. About 160 members of the association were present at the breakfast at Brighton giv en by the National Temperance League. We need not say that the speakers at this meeting were not of the opinion of a recent writer in the *Revue Scientifique*— September 27. M. Fournier de Flaix. 
