FOR BELGIAN RELIEF

Twelfth Carload From County Is
Shipped From Simcoe.

(Canadian Press.)
SIMCOE, Feb. 25.—A carload of
canned goods and flour loaded at Del-
hi and Simcoe left here this afternoon
for Halifax, N.S., for shipment on the
next Belgian relief ship.
This brings the total of Norfolk Coun-
ty contributions to Belgium up to
twelve carloads. The total value of
the shipments will be about \$30,000.

Britain's Expenditure
Nearly Two Billions

Cost of War and Incidentals For One Year—New Estimates
Issued For Credit Vote of Billion and a Quarter
Dollars For 1916.

(Canadian Press.)
London, Feb. 25.—The Supple-
mentary government estimates were
issued this morning, covering the
amounts which will be required to de-
fray the expenses of naval and military
operations, to cover the cost of assisting
with the food supply and in promoting a
continuance of trade, as well as other
expenditures arising from the existing
state of war.

An additional sum of \$185,000,000 will
be necessary to meet the outlay up to
the end of the financial year, closing
with the 31st of March, 1915. This
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present vote credit is a project to put
into operation machinery for the raising
