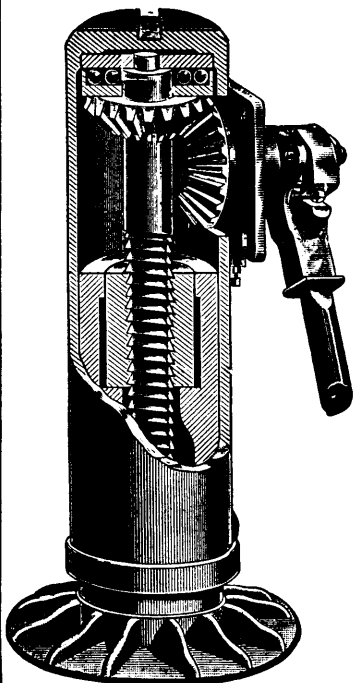

THE GEARS

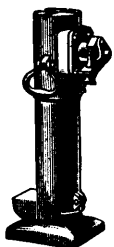
are cut from solid steel forgings, thereby giving highest efficiency and greatest durability.

THE SCREW

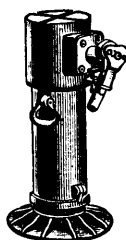

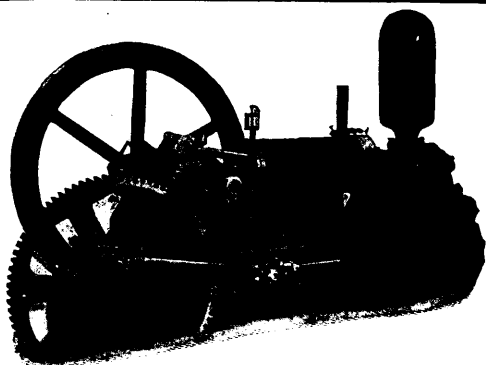

Fairbanks-Morse & Co's Gasoline Combined Pumper

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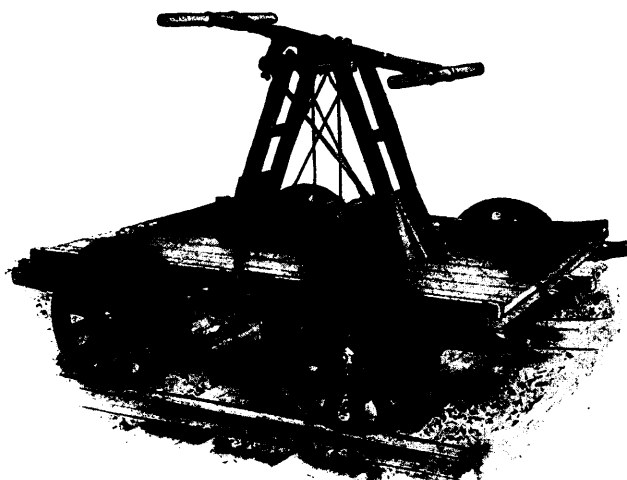
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
