

AMARANTUS BLITOIDES, Wats.

East of Brandon, Man.; Cardston, Alta. (*John Macoun.*)

Not recorded west of Ontario.

MONOLEPIS CHENOPODIoidES, Moq.

Cypress Hills, Assa.; Kananaskis and Banff, Rocky Mts.

(*John Macoun.*) Western limit.

CHENOPODIUM BOTRYS, L.

Waste places, Spence's Bridge, B.C. (*John Macoun.*)

Not recorded west of Ontario.

CHENOPODIUM LEPTOPHYLLUM, Nutt.

Sandy soil, Spence's Bridge, B.C.; Deer Park, Lower Arrow Lake, B.C. (*John Macoun.*) Not recorded west of Rocky Mountains.

CHENOPODIUM LEPTOPHYLLUM, Nutt., var. SUBGLABRUM, Wats.

Sandy woodlands, Pt. Pelee, Essex Co., Ont. 1886. (*Dr. Burgess.*) Neither the type nor variety recorded from Ontario.

CHENOPODIUM URBICUM, L.

Nanaimo and Victoria, Vancouver Island, B.C. 1893.

(*John Macoun.*) Not recorded west of Ontario.

CHENOPODIUM RUBRUM, L.

On brackish flats near the main lighthouse station, Sable Island, N.S. Very rare. 1898. (*John Macoun.*)

SALICORNIA HERBACEA, L.

Borders of saline ponds near Kamloops, B.C. 1890.

(*J. M. Macoun.*) Not recorded from British Columbia.

SALICORNIA AMBIGUA, Mx.

Long Arm, Skidegate Inlet, Queen Charlotte Islands, B.C. (*Dr. C. F. Newcombe.*) Northern limit.

RUMEX PATIENTIA, L.

Not uncommon about houses and in fields, Boylston, N.S.

(*Dr. C. A. Hamilton.*) Not recorded east of Ontario.

SCLERANTHUS ANNUUS, L.; Macoun, Cat. Can. Plants, vol. 1, pp. 80 and 499.

West of London, Ont., 1890; Komoka, Ont., July, 1892.

(*J. Dearness.*) Our only herbarium specimens.
