A QUEBEC telegram of 30th April says that Price Brothers, the famous lumber kings, have cut no less than 160,000 pine logs in Montmagny woods during the past season.

In Nova Scotia, A. McPherson, foundry, Oxford, has failed. So have W. W. Black, furniture; T. B. Babin, grocer, Moncton, N.B., and Bissett & McLoon, grocers, St. John, N.B.

AUCTIONEER BRUNTON, of London, succeeded in getting 79½ cents on the dollar for the dry goods stock of Jno. Wall, Chatham. It was invoiced at \$20,514, and the latter's friends bought it in for him.

A dissolution has taken place in the firm of John McPherson & Co., manufacturers of boots and shoes in Hamilton. Mr. William John McPherson retires and the business is carried on by the remaining partners.
