A "call" is contract to deliver stock at a price shove the current quotation for a similar consideration. A "straddle" is a dual privilege either to receive or deliver stock at a price unsually from two or three per cent. above or below the market figure, the consideration being Privilege in two separate contracts, one "put," the other a "call," the co sideration for which is usually larger than in the other options, say one and a half per cent. There are many other terms used on the Stock Exchange which may be briefly stated and explained. A "break" in the market is a serious decline caused by a stringency in the money market or any other similarly money market or any other similarly potent factor in stock speculations. 


