

- Power, L. J.** North-west Rebellion, 1885. Medal. South African War, 1899-02. Operations in the Orange Free State, February, 1900, including operations at Paardeburg (18 February). Operations in the Transvaal, between 30 November, 1900, and 31 May, 1902. Operations in Cape Colony, between 30 November, 1900, and 31 May, 1902. Queen's Medal with three clasps.
- Pragnell, G.F.S.** (Imp. Army.) South African War, 1901-2. Operations in the Orange River Colony between 30th November, 1900, and 31 May, 1902. Operations in Cape Colony between 30 November 1900, and 31 May, 1902. Queen's Medal and 4 clasps.

- Preston, John Alexander Victor.** (Midland Bn.) North-west Rebellion, 1885. Medal.
- Prevost, Hector.** (65 Bn.) North-west Rebellion, 1885. Operations against Chief Big Bear's Band (May-July), including action at Fernchman's Butte (29 May). Medal with clasp
- Prevost, W.** (Regt. C.A.) North-west Rebellion, 1885. Medal and clasp.
- Price, Arthur John.** (2 Bn. R.C.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in Orange Free State, Feb. to May, 1900, including operations at Paardeburg (17-26 Feb.), and actions at Poplar Grove (7 March), Dreifontein (10 March). Operations in Transvaal, May and June, 1900. Operations in Cape Colony, north of Orange River. Queen's Medal with four clasps.
- Price, E. H.** (2 Bn. R.C.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in Transvaal, May and June, and May, 1900, including action at Zand River (10 May). Operations in Orange River Colony including actions near Johannesburg (29 May), Pretoria (4 June). Operations in Orange River Colony and Transvaal, east and west of Pretoria, 29 June to November, 1900. Queen's Medal with three clasps.
- Price, H.** (Imp. Army.) South African War, 1899-1900. Medal with five clasps.

- Pringle, J.** (2 Bn. R.C.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in the Orange Free State, Feb.-May, 1900, including operations at Paardeburg (17-26 May); action at Poplar Grove (7 March); Dreifontein (10 March); and Karree Siding (29 March); defence of Wepener; actions at Hout Nek (1 May), Vet River (5-6 May), and Zand River (10 May). Operations in Cape Colony, south of Orange River, 1899-1900. Queen's Medal with three clasps.
- Prower, J. Elton.** (8th Regt.) North-west Rebellion, 1885. Medal with clasp.
- Rattray, E. E. B.** (2 Bn. R.C.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in the Orange Free State, February to May, 1900, including action at Zand River (10th May). Operations in the Transvaal in May and June, 1900, including actions near Johannesburg (29th May), Pretoria (4th June). Operations in Cape Colony, south of Orange River, 1899-1900. Queen's Medal with three clasps.
- Ray, W. J.** Fenian Raid, 1870. General Service Medal with one clasp.
- Read, H.** (R.C.F.A. and 3 Regt. C.M.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in Natal, 1899, including Redpath, S. J. (Natal Carabineers). South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in Natal, 1899, including actions at Elandsplaagte (21st October), and Lombard's Kop (30th October). Defence of Ladysmith, including sorties of 7th and 10th December, 1899, and action of 6th January, 1900. Distinguished conduct medal and Queen's Medal with two clasps.
- Redway, E. H.** (2 Bn. R.C.R.) South African War, 1899-1900. Operations in Orange Free State, February to May, 1900, including operations at Paardeburg (17 to 26 February); actions at Poplar Grove (7 March), and Prefontaine (10 March) and Karree Siding (29 March). Defence of Wepener, actions at Houtnek (1 May), Vet River (5 and 6 May) and Zand River (10 May). Operations in the Transvaal in May and June, 1900, including actions near Johannesburg (29 May), Pretoria (4 June), and Diamond Hill (11 and 12 June). Queen's Medal with four clasps.
- Reford, A. G.** (C.M.R.) South Africa, 1899-1902. Operations in the Transvaal between 30 November, 1900 and 31 May, 1902. Operations in the Cape Colony, between 30 November, 1900 and 31 May, 1902. Queen's Medal, 3 clasps.
- Reid, D. A.** (2nd C.M.R.) South African War, 1900-1902. Operations in the Orange Free State, February to May, 1900, including operations at Paardeburg (17th to 26th February); actions at Poplar Grove, (7th March); Dreifontein, (10th March), Operations in Cape Colony, between 30th November, 1900, and 31st May, 1902. Queen's Medal with three clasps.
- Reid, H. G.** (Imp. Army.) South African War, 1901-1902. Operations in the Transvaal, July, 1901, to 31 May, 1902. Operations in Orange River Colony, July, 1901. Operations in Cape Colony, February to June, 1901. Queen's Medal with five clasps.
- Reynolds, H. F.** (Nesbitt's Horse). South African War, 1900-02. Operations in Orange River Colony, May to 28th November, 1900, including actions at Biddulphsberg (29th May), Lindley (1st June), Rhenoster River (11th June), Lindley (29th June), Bethelhem (6th and 7th July), Wittebergen (1st to 29th July), Witpoort (15th August), Ladybrand (2nd to 5th September), Bothaville (5th November), Caledon River (27th to 29th November, 1900). Operations in Cape Colony, between 30th November, 1900, and 31st May, 1902. Queen's medal with three clasps.
