The Ambassador of Canada presents his compliments to the Secretary of State of the United States and has the honour to refer to the latter's note of December 20, 1955 expressing the willingness of the United States Government that the United States Armed Services in Canada should participate on behalf of their Canadian employees in the program of the Canadian Unemployment Insurance Act.

The Canadian Government is pleased to concur in this arrangement and understands that, subject to the availability of funds, the United States Armed Forces in Canada will participate, commencing July 1, 1956, in the Canadian Unemployment Insurance program on behalf of their Canadian employees in Canada.

The Canadian Government further understand that the term 'Canadian employees' covers residents of Canada whether or not they are Canadian citizens, provided they are not eligible to acquire credits under any unemployment insurance law of the United States in respect of the same employment.
