<u>Reservation</u>	
"Whereas Canada is desirous of acceding to the Convention on Psychotropic Substances, 1971, and whereas Canada's population includes certain small clearly determined groups who use in magical or religious rites certain psychotropic substances of plant origin included in the schedules to the said Convention, and whereas the said substances occur in plants which grow in North America but not in Canada, a reservation of any present of future application, if any, of the provisions of the said Convention to peyote is hereby made pursuant to Article 32, paragraph 3 of the Convention."
