Political Developments in the FRY and in the "Near Abroad"

Summary:

Yugoslavian president Slobodan Milosevic and his supporters remain in political control of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and Serbia, as well as in the Serb republic of Bosnia-Herzegovina. This persistence can be explained in large part by the weakness of the opposition, despite the victories of the *Zajedno* opposition coalition in the February 1997 elections, and the failure of the opposition to unite. Against this background, the results of the legislative and presidential elections in Serbia of December 1997 are examined.
