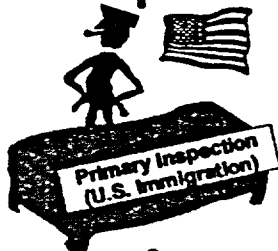
If answers are unacceptable, traveller proceeds to Secondary Inspection

- possession of drugs, agricultural goods and currency

If answers are acceptable, traveller proceeds to U.S. Customs



Passenger answers questions regarding:

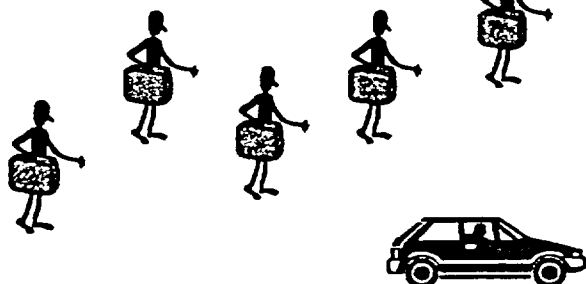
- citizenship
