His Excellency Eduardo Brazão today presented to His Excellency the Governor-General his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Portugal. The ceremony took place at Government House. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General.

Mr. Marcel Cadieux, Deputy Under-Secretary for External Affairs and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General, were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.

The Ambassador was accompanied by Dr. Antonio Baptista Martins, Second Secretary of the Embassy.

Dr. Brazão, a Law graduate from the University of Lisbon, joined the Foreign Ministry in 1941. He has, since then, served at the Holy See, in Madrid, Hong Kong and Dublin. He was appointed Ambassador to Italy in 1958.
