The Annual Spring Ministerial Meeting of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization will take place in The Hague from May 12-14. In accordance with the usual procedure for spring meetings of NATO, the Foreign Ministers of member countries will attend. This year's meeting will be devoted primarily to a review of the international situation and to a discussion of the Secretary General's annual political appraisal. Canada will be represented by the Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin.

After the conclusion of the NATO meeting, Mr. Martin will visit the Federal Republic of Germany as a guest of the German Foreign Minister, Dr. Gerhard Schroeder. He will visit Bonn on May 15 for talks with Dr. Schroeder and German officials. He will visit Berlin on May 16 and return to Ottawa on May 17.
