

(1) The Minister shall publish in the Canada Gazette a copy of each performance objective issued under paragraph (1)(b) as soon as possible after it is issued.

(2) Any matter falling within the jurisdiction of the Minister may, by order of the Minister, be referred

(a) to the Commission for its advice and the Commission shall report to the Minister;

(b) to a provincial regulatory body for its advice, with the consent of the appropriate provincial Minister.

7. (1) The Minister may, with the consent of the Governor in Council, enter into an agreement with the government of a province reporting

(a) the exercise by the Minister of the powers of such powers which are functions of a provincial regulatory body as specified in the agreement;

(b) the exercise of a provincial regulatory body of such powers, duties or functions as of the Minister of the Commission under the Act as are specified in the agreement.

(2) The agreement specified pursuant to subsection (1) shall be entered into by the Minister without prior approval by order of the Governor in Council.

(3) The Governor in Council may, by order, provide for the carrying out of any agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (1) or for giving effect to any of the provisions thereof.

(4) Subject otherwise specified in an agreement entered into under paragraph (1)(b),

(a) the Minister shall, as it appears to be necessary to secure by legislative regulation or otherwise, the rights of the Ministry in relation to Canada in telecommunications matters and consult the Commission with respect to any such matters and

(b) consult with provincial governments and other appropriate authorities, organizations or persons for the purpose of promoting the orderly development of telecommunications in Canada.
