Ernest Lapointe and Hugues Lapointe, and Sir Charles Tupper and Sir Charles Hibbert Tupper; courage displayed by member for Vancouver North (Mr. Sinclair) in speech on address; visit of their majesties a year ago, 22; death of Lord Tweedsmuir, 23; appointment of Earl of Athlone as governor general; government returned in recent general election by about 54 per cent of votes polled, with about 75 or 80 per cent of seats in the house; meaning of mandate received by prime minister from the people of Canada, not for a limited liability contribution; National Conservative party; retirement of Doctor Manion from position as leader of the opposition; amendment of British North America Act to provide for system of national unemployment insurance, 24; position of provinces on invasion of their rights
