You will possibly remember telling me that you had not received a copy of the booklet just issued by the 16th Brigade on the North Russian Expedition, & I venture to send you another copy because the wish has been so generally expressed by members of the Brigade, practically all of whom served under you in France, that their old Corps Commander should receive one, & because the mail service fell down in connection with the first copy is no reason why you should be left without one.

It may interest you to know that, on leaving Russia, General Drowside told the Brigade that "the highest traditions of the Canadian Corps have been fully maintained".
