

MILITARY INSTRUCTION

UNIVERSITY of TORONTO.

Course covers three years, beginning in second year

Students must have had some previous military training.

Time required by academic part of course.

Second year - 2 hours per week

Third and fourth years - 3 hours per week

Subjects covered in course

- a. Professional subjects comprising the work required for the C.O.T.C. certificates "A" and "B".
- b. Lectures of citizenship, relations between the various parts of the Empire with regard to defence, trade-routes, coal and fuel stations, naval power, and the distribution of the Empire's armed forces.

Credit towards degree.

May be chosen as an elective course counting towards a degree.

Practical Work.
