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- X. Water rates to be collected in the same manner as taxes on real estate.
- XI. A majority of the Commissioners to be a quorum. Engagements and acts of the Commissioners to be obligatory on the Corporation.
- XII. Commissioners may prosecute or defend actions in their corporate name. No vacancy or change in the Board to affect any such action.
- XIII. They and their officers to be protected in the execution of their duties, in like manner as justices of the peace.
- XIV. Corporation may raise £300,000 by loan, for the purposes of this Act. Debentures for 30 years may be issued therefor.
- XV. The water-works and land pertaining thereto to be mortgaged for the above loan.
- XVI. Moneys accruing from such debentures to be lodged in a Bank, and to be withdrawn only for the purposes of this Act.
- XVII. Act not to take effect until a By-law shall have been passed by the Corporation. The Mayor thereupon to issue his warrant for election of a Water Commissioner for each Ward, in the same manner as for municipal elections.
- XVIII. Term of office regulated.
- XIX. One Water Commissioner to be elected each year, to serve for five years. Vacancies to be filled up by the Corporation.
- XX. Commissioners to be paid by the Corporation.
- XXI. Public Act.
