hopes to visit all the remaining Missions, and if possible to reach every family belonging to our communion throughout the Diocese.

The Board take pleasure in informing the Society that the Rev. G. V. Housman, being about to visit England, they have appointed that gentleman in conjunction with the Rev. Dr. Mackie, a Deputation to bring the claims of the Church in this Diocese before the members of the Church at home.
