MONTREAL WOOLLEN MILLS.

Mr. LENNOX asked:

Has the attention of the government been called to the press announcement that the Montreal Woollen Mills will be compelled to permanently close down by the 1st of April next, owing, as is alleged, to the unsatisfac-tory condition of Canadian Tariff Laws?

Hon. W. S. FIELDING (Minister of Finance). The government has no information or the subject beyond what has appeared in the press.

HOLLAND RIVER CANAL.

Mr. LENNOX asked:

1. Who were employed to value the land of the right of way for the canal from Holland river to Newmarket, and were these parties entrusted with any other duties than valuation of lands?

2. What was the remuneration of each of these valuators? 3. For how long were they employed, and

upon what terms?

4. (a) What properties did they value, (b) at what amount or rate in each case, (c) what was the acreage of each property, (d) in how many cases, by names, were the valua-tions accepted by the owners, (e) in how many cases by names, were the valuations finally rejected by the owners, (f) in what cases were expropriation proceedings resorted to, and (a) with what result accepted with robust (g) with what result as compared with valua-tors' figures?

5. Have titles to all properties been required?

Hon. GEO. P. GRAHAM (Minister of Railways and Canals). This will be quite a lengthy return. My hon. friend had better let it stand as a notice of motion for a return.

Mr. LENNOX. Will it make any difference in time?

Mr. GRAHAM. No, it will take the same length of time. It will take a great many sheets to contain the information.

Mr. SPEAKER. Stands as a notice of motion for a return.

what is the annual rent? 3. Should the tenant desire to surrender his lease, would the government be disposed to grant his request?

Hon. GEO. P. GRAHAM (Minister of Railways and Canals): 1. Yes; to N. and A. Bourbonnais.

annum, during pleasure. (b) Second par-cel of land containing $6\frac{1}{2}$ acres, for a term of 21 years, at \$39 per annum.

Hon. W. S. FIELDING (Minister of Finance). Dividends, \$3,864.19; deposits or bal-ances, \$556,332.91.

1. What sections in townships 30 and 31, range 22, are included in the permit held by Theo. A. Burrows? 2. Are there any more sections granted to him under permit?

3. If so, what is the location and description?

4. What expenditure does the department make annually protecting these holdings from trespass?

5. How many years can these timber lands be held without operation?

6. Has the permit holder the right to ab-solutely denude these lands of every stick of timber?
