SYSTEM OF SPELLING HERE ADOPTED.

Vowels and diphthongs:—

a	as in <i>fat</i> .	ō	as in <i>pole</i> .
ā	„ <i>father</i> .	ū	„ <i>cut</i> .
e	„ <i>met</i> .	ū	„ <i>truly</i> .
ē	„ <i>fête</i> .	au	„ <i>aught</i> .
i	„ <i>pit</i> .	ou	„ <i>loud</i> .
ī	„ <i>pique</i> .	eu	„ <i>feudal</i> .
o	„ <i>lot</i> .	ai	„ <i>aisle</i> .

Consonants:—

- g always hard, as in *go*.
- j as in *jest*.
- k as *ch* in *loch*.
- s always light, as in *sit*.
- ch as in *chip*.
- w and y are used only as consonants.

lth represents a sound made by expelling the breath while the tip of the tongue touches the palate.

Hyphens are occasionally introduced to aid the reader in dividing the syllables.
