ELECTION BYE-LAWS.

ELECTION OF OFEICERS.

- 1. That the Officers be elected by ballot.
- 2. That the candidate who shall receive a majority of all the votes cast be declared duly elected.
- 3. That in case of more than two being nominated for one office, and at the first ballot there being no majority of the whole for any one caddidate, that the candidate who shall have received the lowest number of votes be struck off the list, and that the balloting be continued in the same manner until one is elected.
- 4. That two Scrutineers be appointed, whose duty it shall be to see that the election is conducted in a proper manner, at the end of each poll to count the votes and report the same to the Chairman, whose duty it shall be to declare the result of the poll.
 - 5. No member shall be allowed to vote by proxy.
- 6. No candidate shall be allowed to run for more than one office.

RULES OF ORDER.

1. It shall be the duty of the Chairman to state every question properly to the meeting, and before putting it to vote, he shall ask: "Is the meeting ready for the question?" Should no member offer to speak, he shall rise to put it, and after he has risen no member shall be permitted to speak upon it.
