MEANS OF ACCESS TO THE EASTERN TOWNSHIPS.

The Grand Trunk Railway Company of Canada have made such arrangements that Emigrants can for one payment obtain tickets that will enable them to travel from London, Liverpool, or other port of embarkation, to their destination in Canada, without any additional charge, beyond that for provisions while on land. Emigrants are strongly recommended to avail themselves of the facilities afforded by the through-ticket arrangements of the Grand Trunk Railway Company, by means of which passengers secure the free transmission of their luggage, within reasonable limits as to weight and dimensions, from the port of departure to their destination, and avoid many impositions and incidental expenses that might otherwise occur to them.
