Equivalent to Veto.

Mr. Aylesworth replied. He must oppose the amendment. The bill as drafted was a compromise bill. It probably would not be adopted by a single province in Canada. Therefore it would be equivalent to defeating the bill to give the provinces any powers of veto or confirmation.

Mr. Bourassa quoted Mr. Aylesworth to show that parliament could provide that this law should not come into effect in any province unless and until

In 1902 the Dominion Medical Act was passed by this parliament and a clause was added providing that it should not come into force until ratified by all the provinces.
