BELGIUM'S KING AND QUEEN ENTERTAINED BY FRENCH PRESIDENT

Bonds of Friendship Drawn Closer at Paris Function.

Paris, Dec. 5.—King Albert, Queen Elizabeth and Prince Leopold of Belgium were guests of honor at a banquet given by President Poincare at the Elysée Palace tonight.

200 guests present, including members of the French cabinet, allied diplomats and prominent officials. During the dinner the Republican Guards Band ereigns received the guests of the evening. Toasts of the utmost cordiality were exchanged by President Poincare and King Albert, the bonds of friendship forged during the four years of warfare by the two nations being referred to in most eloquent terms by each of the speakers.

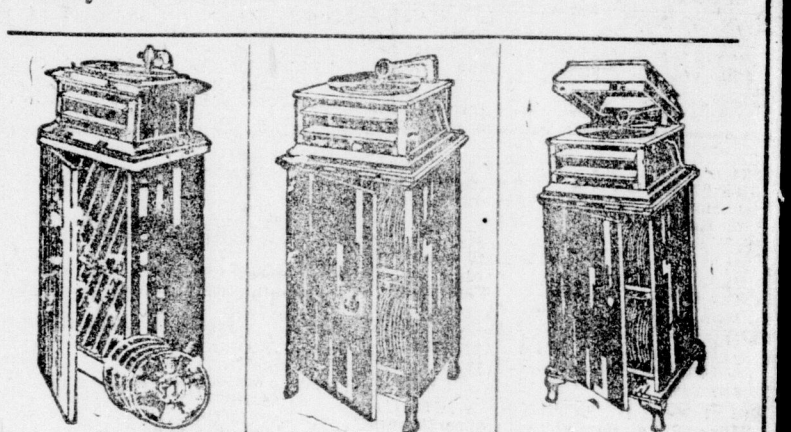
