Resolved:—"That the Grand Division should expect, and reasonably does expect that members who are thus favored should either attend the meetings of the Grand Division, or forward to the Grand Division, such sum or sums of money, as they may each feel able to pay, the money so received to be devoted to the Lecture Fund."
