IEWSH LAW LORD URGES HS

PEOPLE TO JOIN COLORS

London, April 17.—Lord Reading, Lord Chief Justice of England, speaking at a Jewish recruiting meeting in London said:

"England's appeal for methods are to be regarded as belonging to a private individual, or whether the Kaiser is to be considered as the representative of an enemy state. If the former interpretation holds the dominion officials are powerless to interfere, even though the individual concerned be the sovereign of a hostile nation.

The Emperor William is also said to have a large interest in the Hohenzollern block of the New York City loan, the interest on which is payable through London.
