

## REDS BLAMED FOR RIOTS IN ATHENS

Fourteen Dead, 170 Injured; Ten Royalist Leaders Are Arrested

ATHENS, Greece, Sept. 10.—Premier Kondylis today declared that the riot scenes in Athens (following yesterday's mutiny by the Republican Guards), were caused by Communists and a few Royalists wishing to take advantage of the situation and cause the overthrow of the republic.

The government has arrested ten Royalist leaders and participants. The number of dead is placed at 14, and the injured at 170. Some of the newspapers, however, say the mutineers lost 30 killed and many wounded, but say the casualties among the regular troops and citizens are not known.

Colonels Zervas and Dertilis, who commanded the riotous guards, were taken to the general secretly last night.

## Uses Barber To Help Him In Suicide

PRINCE ALBERT, Sept. 11.—James Alfred Murray, of Edmonton, serving a two-year sentence in the penitentiary here for burglary, committed suicide in a unique manner. While being shaved by another prisoner, he seized the barber's hand and drew the razor across his own throat. Before he expired he absolved the barber prisoner from any blame.

## EX-PREMIER'S WIFE IN SMUGGLING CASE

ATHENS, Sept. 10.—The charge that Mme. Pangalos, wife of the former president, smuggled silk into Athens regularly and sold it during her husband's dictatorship, has been made by the Athens Merchant Board before a governmental commission. Mme. Pangalos, testifying, said she had authorized the modiste to import a small quantity, but that the latter had abused the favor.

## WILL ARMOR BANK LIKE BATTLESHIP

Midland, in London City, Will Be Encased in Concrete and Steel

LONDON, Sept. 11.—Devices to make the building the most burglar-proof bank in the world are being used in the construction of the new headquarters of the Midland Bank in the city of London.

The bank is to be armored almost like a battleship. Tons of iron, concrete and steel plates will encase it to prevent burglars from burrowing their way to the strong-rooms.

It will be five years before the building is completed, and it will not only be the safest, but one of the most imposing in the city.

## Magic Carpet Valued At Over \$500,000

LONDON, Sept. 10.—A magic carpet nearly 400 years old and valued at over \$500,000 held an almost reverential little group awe-struck at a carpet dealer's premises in Holborn recently.

At first sight it seemed to consist of a jumble of rich colors. Slowly, however, the design became apparent and the eye revelled in the wonderfully rich lines of ruby, emerald green and amber.

The romantic history of the carpet was unfolded by James F. Ballard, a rich American, whose hobby for twenty years has been the collecting of rare and beautiful carpets.

"This carpet," he said, "was made at Ispahan in 1550, in the reign of Shah Safi. It was presented by the Shah to Peter the Great, who in turn presented it to Leopold I. of Austria."

"The carpet then hung for a long time on the wall of the staircase in the Palace at Schoenbrunn, near Vienna. It was later seized by the State, and was recently sold by the Austrian

government to Cardinal and Harford, of London.

## BRITISH CARGO SHIP ARRIVES AT CANTON

CANTON, Sept. 10.—The first British cargo steamer to dock since the anti-British strike and boycott started, more than a year ago, arrived here late yesterday. It was escorted by gunboats, and unmolested. This was attributed to cessation of picket activities. The British government recently warned pickets that they would be treated as pirates and that no more interference with British shipping would be tolerated.






