

on our poles. Probably for the time being, it could be arranged for the N. B. Power Company to allow us to insulate such wires on our poles that are in close proximity with them, until such time as this matter can be straightened away.

In reference to the erection of the ornamental street lighting system, we find that there will be considerable interference from the poles of the N. B. Power Company and the N. B. Telephóne Company that are not perpendicular and as the main feeder for the ornamental system is of 2,300 voltage (potential), it is necessary to supply the contractor with extension arms in order to give us the necessary clear-ance. These arms can be used for the secondary distribution of light and power and I would ask authority to get prices from our local foundaries and to award tender to the lowest tenderer at as early a date as possible.




