Swiss Workman in Baden Tunes His Dole into German Marks.

Karlshaus, May 8—How to build up a fortune on an unemployment dole is told by a Swiss workman who lives at Constance, which is on the Swiss side of the lake of that name, although the town itself belongs to Baden.

He draws the dole, ten Swiss francs a day, turns it into about 600 German marks, spends 100 marks on food and lodgings, and saves a clear 500 marks a day.

He has just bought a house for 40,000 marks.
