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- Q You are sure, are you, that you have never been in the Army before?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Any other Branch of the Army?
- A No, Sir.
- Q When you enlisted in January of this year, you didn't really want to get into the Army, did you?
- A Well, I guess I would have been just like anybody else, if I had been refused I would have been happy.
- Q As a matter of fact, you expected to be turned down on a Medical, didn't you?
- A Yes, I did.
- Q You claimed you had trouble with your breathing?
- A Not exactly with my breathing, Sir, but another trouble I had.
- Q It wasn't your breathing that was bothering you, but something to do with your nose?
- A Yes, I had trouble with my nose.
- Q And Rheumatism?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Indigestion?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q And you were accepted into the Army?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q And posted to the 103rd Training Centre?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q And it was from the 103rd you went absent on the 29th day of May, 1945, is it?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Were you on a pass then, or did you just walk out of the Training Centre?
- A I was on a pass.
- Q That is when you were due back, was it?
- A I think that is when I left. I left Fort Gerry in May and I was supposed to be back on the 28th or 29th, Sir.
- Q And you didn't get back?
- A No, Sir.
- Q And you were apprehended by the Civil Police in Fort Frances on the 20th day of July, 1945?
- A Yes, Sir.
