MEMORANDUM:

For the Asst. Secretary:—

The Burnt Church Band has at its credit \$2760 part of which could be used for the purpose named in Mr. Carter's letter of the 11th instant, upon authority of the Governor-in-Council being obtained. It would be necessary that the Band pass a proper resolution agreeing to the expenditure being made from its funds, which resolution should be certified by the Agent. The document enclosed by Mr. Carter is simply a letter and the signatures are nearly all in the same hand writing and not witnessed. No other funds are available.
