An Act to amend the Railway Act with respect to
the shipment of grain.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the
Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows:—

1. Subsection 1 of section 246 of *The Railway Act*, chapter 1888, c. 29, s.
5 29 of the statutes of 1888, is hereby amended by adding at ^{246 amended.}
the end thereof the following words:—

“In the case of grain, every railway company shall afford ^{Facilities for}
all reasonable facilities at all way stations or shipping points ^{shipping}
for receiving it into its cars directly from the farmers' vehicles, ^{grain.}
10 platforms or warehouses in or upon which it is when so offered
for transportation; and every railway company failing to pro-
vide reasonable shipping facilities as hereinbefore provided
shall be liable for damages thereby caused to any person
offering grain for transportation ”
