

operations. I would recommend that a person should be sent to supervise these Sioux, and also those at the Bird Tail Creek, and direct them when and how to go to work.

If this suggestion should be adopted; they should be prohibited from coming to Winnipeg, and whatever aid might be given, should be given only on the Reserves. If this step be taken, and a competent person selected, I believe that in a short time they would cultivate the soil, raise cattle, and make a sufficient living for themselves.
