## TRANSLATION

(Extract of speech of Dr. H. Deslauriers, at Inauguration of Club Martin' at Paro Lafontains, Montreal, July 1926.)

"The Gustoms Probe has revealed nothing added Mr. Dealauriers.

It has served only to soil us and anger the populations of the other provinces against us. "I do not ment to criticise the Governor General, nor do I munt to speak of him, but I will say that he has been Mr. Meighen's election agent."

"Byng felt more powerful than the people. It had been said that Mackensie King being too much in favour of autonomy to attend the Imperial Conference, Mr. Meighen "the walst of the Empire" should be present in his stead! And for this reason, assess to power was facilitated Mr. Meighen."
