Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 25th ult^o, reporting in regard to Dr Bowman's attendance upon the Indian Louis Corbier, and the ~~assessmt~~ charge in the doctor's account for travelling expenses in visiting the Indian; and in reply I beg to say that it is gathered from your letter that you arranged for the doctor's transport, and that A.A. Corbeau and S.A. Gendron were paid for it, and that therefore Dr Bowman should not have included an item of \$14.00 travelling expenses in connection with this case in his account, in addition to the \$16.00 charged for his services. If such is the case then you should obtain a refund of \$14.00 from Dr Bowman and forward to the Department.
