Ottawa, February 18, 1909.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, inclosing copy of a resolution passed by the Council of Muncieys of the Thames band, requesting permission for James Wolfe to cut and sell scattered timber on lot 6, range 7, and in reply to inform you that you may examine the lot and decide whether or not the land cut over should be cleared, fenced and put under cultivation, or sown with sufficient grass and clover seed to prevent the growth of noxious weeds.

If the area to be cut over is large, you may exercise your own judgment in deciding whether it would be advisable to permit the whole extent to be cut over, or only a part of it, having regard to the future wants of the holder of the lot.
