

Ottawa, 27th November, 1891.

Sir:-

I have to request that you will inform Chief Isaac Hill, in reply to his letter of the 11th instant, enquiring if orders were sent to cause the people to vote in regard to the question of paying the costs of the law suit between the two Agricultural Societies and whether a decision has been come to that the Six Nation funds would not be charged with payment of such costs, that instructions were sent to you by the Department to put the question to a vote of the male members of the Community of 21 years and over, but, inasmuch as the members of the Six Nations have by a majority of 201 votes decided against the payment of the costs of the suit, they will not be paid.
