Rev. Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant relative to the misunder-standing between your Society and the Department in regard to the names of the Swan Lake (or White Bear) school and the Moose Mountain school; and in reply I would suggest, to prevent misunderstanding in future, that the school of which Mr Garriach is teacher be known as the Swan Lake school, and the school known to you as Moose Mountain be called "White Bear's as it is situated on White Bear's reserve in the Moose: Mountain Agency.
