
Ottawa, 29th April, 1904.

Sir :-

The Department has been informed that Mr. Arthur Gibeault, who has been entrusted with the construction of the main drain on the Caughnawaga Reserve, has met with considerable antagonism from the Indian Council.

I have, therefore, to request that you will point out to the Council that the said work of drainage should have been constructed by the Indians or out of their funds in accordance with the provisions of Section 34 of the Indian Act, and, in view of the fact that they have not been called upon for funds for this purpose, the required amount having been voted by Parliament, the Department expects that they will assist Mr. Gibeault in every way possible.
