
Ottawa, 16th February, 1906.

Sir,-

I enclose a blue print showing the location of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway through the Muscowequan Indian reserve, No. 85, approved by the Deputy Minister of Railways and Canals.

The total area of land required for right of way and station purposes is 164.80 acres, <sup>more or less.</sup> I have to request you to value this land at a rate per acre. You will also be good enough to value separately any damages that may be done to Indian improvements, giving the name of each Indian injured, with the character and amount of the damage sustained.
