Madam,-

In reply to your letter of the 18th, instant, I beg to say that the Department has decided to appoint you as teacher of the Chetlain Indian day school at a salary of \$500.00 per annum, and you will be expected to commence your duties, there, on Tuesday September 3rd, next. Enclosed is a copy of the Indian day school regulations.

It will be necessary for you to secure your ticket to Nyanda Junction, which is on the Ottawa and New York railway.

If you communicate with Mr. F. E. Taillon, Indian Agent, St. Regis, Que., he will furnish full information in regard to a boarding house, and its distance from the school. You should also inform him at what time you will arrive at Nyanda Junction.
