

SUB - COUNCILSPROCEDURE

The procedure of all sub-councils shall be the same as shown under the heading:--

" CONTROL OF REGIONAL PROBLEMS "

Book I Section C Page 30

EXCEPTIONS

Exceptions to the procedure of sub-councils as laid out under "Control of Regional Problems" in Book I, Section C, Page 30, shall be as follows:-

- (a) All sub-councils are of a permanent nature, except the Regional Control sub-councils.
- (b) All cases brought before the sub-councils shall be decided within the period of three (3) months. Exception:- Regional Control Sub-Councils.
- (c) An extension of six (6) weeks may be granted by the International Court, if deemed necessary.
- (d) There shall be only one (1) extension of time granted on any one matter.

The important difference in the International Court and its Sub-Councils as outlined in these plans is that instead of various international matters being controlled by different organizations, each with its own set of rules and influences, all international matters
