Also designed to improve living conditions among those who, largely as result of depression, were unable to undertake need improvements and repairs to their homes;

Since its inception, more than 46,000 loans have been made under the plan to householders who required assistance;

(4) Farm Improvement and Employment Plan:

Also recommended by Commission and put into operation in fall of 1936;

Primarily intended to take care, particularly during winter months, of unemployed single men - formerly in relief camps -

(Camps had been closed, July 1, 1936, at which time many of men had been given special work on railways or assisted in finding other employment; problem, of course, increased in winter months);

Under Plan, more than 100,000 placements have been made on farms or in other branches of primary industry;
