At 1100 hours on August, 29, 1948, I took
off solo in Cub J-3 CF-DMC with the intention of flying
out Allenby way.

At about 400 feet a fire started in front of the
bulk head, I, tried to side slip away from the flame, but
the smoke was bad and the right wing hit the ground and
the aircraft cartwheeled, I managed to escape without
injuries. The aircraft burned to ashes along with the log-
books.
