Sec. 5.—Every member of this Lodge, on the day of his, admission as a Master Mason shall be directed by the Master to sign these Bye-Laws in the Lodge Book kept for that purpose; and the Master shall cause a copy of them to be given to each member on his signature being attached thereto, that every Brother may know and inform himself of his Masonic duties.

Extracts from Bye-Laws of District Grand Lodge of Newfoundland.

"No. 6-The following, payments shall be made by the Lodges in the District of Newfoundland to the District Grand Lodge, viz. :

"(8) The members of the Grand Lodge shall pay
