THE CANADIAN NORTH-WEST HOMESTEAD

REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitobe or the Northwest Territories, excepting 8 and 26, which has not been home-readed, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 13 years of age, to the extent of one-narter section of 160 acres, more cr less.

ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken is stuate, or if the homesteader desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee entry. entry.
of \$10 is charged for a homestead

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted ar entry for a homestead is recuired by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto, to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of the following plans:—

(I) At least six months' residence unon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

unon and cultivation of the land in seab year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any persen who is eligible to make a homestead entry unon the provisions of this Act, resides unon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for vanch norson as a homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence prior to obtaining nature that he arised he want person residing with the father or mother.

(3) If a settier has obtained a parent for his homestead, or a certificate for the issue of such patent countersigned in the manner precibed by this Act, and has obtained entry for a second homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be astisfied by residence upon the first homestead, if the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his per-

stead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said lead.

of this Act as to residence may be astisfied by residence upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used shove is meant to indicate the same fownish or an adjoining or connecting township.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2) (3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acres of his homestead, or substitute 20 head of stock, with buildines for their accommodation, and have healdes 80 acres substantially fenced.

Every homesteader who falls toximply with the requirements of the homesteader law is liable to have his entry cancelled, and the land may be again thrown open for entry.
