the harbour of Saint John, for exportation, the same shall be forfeited, proceeded against, and applied in the manner prescribed in and by the third Section of the herein before recited Act.

IV. And be it further enacted, that the said recited Act be, and the same is hereby further concontinued, excrying where
tinued (excepting where the same is hereby aluntil att April. tered and amended,) and declared to be in full 1820. force until the first day of April, which will be in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and no longer.

CAP. XIX.

An ACT to appropriate a part of the Public Revenue for the services therein mentioned. Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the Province, unto the several Persons hereafter mentioned, the following sums, to wit,---
